

# **Priority**

River Closure means that the event is controlled by the EA (<u>WaterwaysThames@environment-agency.gov.uk</u>) and other clubs must not organise events at that time. River closures can only be applied between November and March.



**River Restriction** means that the event is controlled by the EA (<u>WaterwaysThames@environment-agency.gov.uk</u>), the river is restricted and other clubs must not organise events in the restricted section at that time.

River Closures and Restrictions can be checked on the EA web site at <a href="https://www.gov.uk/guidance/river-thames-restrictions-and-closures">https://www.gov.uk/guidance/river-thames-restrictions-and-closures</a> . Organisations wishing to have a Restriction or River Closure for their event need to apply to the EA in good time.

**Exclusive (Excl)** means that other clubs participating in this Reach Coordination must not organise events at the same time on the section of the Reach used for the Exclusive event. (When possible, sailing clubs are expected to offer races in the event for all the classes sailing on the Reach.)

**Priority (Pri)** means that the club has priority for its event and other clubs wishing to organise events on the same day MUST liaise with it prior to the event or ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT in order to avoid clashes. If the river is required for part of the day, the times of the event should be stipulated.

**Information (Info)** included in the calendar for information to other Reach users that an event is taking place outside the regular club activities described in 3 below and the nature, timing and location of that event.
