

2 – Programme of events along each reach

The reach programme that is made up by each reach calendar includes only special events for which a degree of priority is agreed - details about the level of priority is given below. Many clubs also have regular activities as listed in <u>section 3, below</u>.

Each event in the calendar is given one of the labels listed below used to indicate the level of priority:

- River Closure means that the event is controlled by the EA (<u>WaterwaysThames@environment-agency.gov.uk</u>) and other clubs must not organise events at the stated time. River closures can only be applied between November and March.
- River Restriction means that the event is controlled by the EA (<u>WaterwaysThames@environment-agency.gov.uk</u>), the river is restricted and other clubs must not organise events in the restricted section at the stated time.
- Exclusive (Excl) means that other clubs participating on the same reach must not organise events at the stated time. (When possible, sailing clubs are expected to offer races in the event for all the classes sailing on the reach.)
- **Priority (Pri)** means that the club has priority for its event and other clubs wishing to organise events on the same day MUST liaise with the club/event organisers prior to the event, in order to avoid clashes. If the river is required for only part of the day, the times of the event should be stipulated.
- **Information (Info)** included in the calendar for information to other river users that an event is taking place outside regular club activities (described in <u>section 3</u>, <u>below</u>) and the nature, timing and location of that event.
